Daniel 7: 9-10, 13-14

As I watched, thrones were set in place, and an Ancient One took his throne; his clothing was white as snow, and the hair of his head like pure wool; his throne was fiery flames, and its wheels were burning fire.

A stream of fire issued and flowed out from his presence. A thousand thousand served him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood attending him. The court sat in judgement, and the books were opened.

As I watched in the night visions, I saw one like a human being coming with the clouds of heaven. And he came to the Ancient One and was presented before him. Who regards the power of your wrath and your indignation like those who fear you?

So teach us to number our days that we may apply our hearts to wisdom.

- Turn again, O Lord; how long will you delay? Have compassion on your servants.
- Satisfy us with your loving-kindness in the morning, that we may rejoice and be glad all our days.
- Give us gladness for the days you have afflicted us, and for the years we have seen adversity.

Show your servants your works, and let your glory be over their children.
